

DAKOTA CURLING CLUB
COVID-19 POLICIES

At the time of publication, this document represents the intended policies for Dakota Curling Club with respect to COVID. This policy **will be updated** on an ongoing basis to ensure compliance and support the wellbeing of the club and our members.

- 1) Vaccinations are not mandatory, but are strongly encouraged
- 2) Masks are not mandatory, but strongly encouraged
- 3) Social distancing is strongly encouraged when indoors
- 4) All entrants must comply with all signage and directions/instructions from staff and this policy
- 5) All entrants must self-screen for COVID symptoms using the sign posted at the entrance. Those with symptoms shall not curl and depart the building as soon as reasonably possible.
- 6) Any persons who have had contact with a known or suspected COVID case shall not enter the club until receiving a NEGATIVE COVID test result.
- 7) Any person awaiting a COVID test result shall not enter the building until receiving a confirmed, NEGATIVE test result and being symptom free for 24 hours. In the event you believe an exception should be made, please contact president@dakotacurling.org for approval before entering the club.
- 8) Any person with a positive test result shall follow the current guidance from the CDC and/or MDH to determine when they may return to the club.
- 9) Club equipment
 - a) Common use items (stone handles, brooms, stabilizers, scoreboard) must be sanitized after each use (end of draw) by the user or designated person per team (Leagues, HS Practice)
 - b) Minimize sharing of equipment between players
 - c) Staff will sanitize after use by any outside (non-league) group

Key Reminders:

If you are sick (including non-COVID), do not come to the club

The COVID policy will be reviewed and updated as conditions and compliance requirements change.
