

DCC Club Participation Policy

The Dakota Curling Club is a non-profit organization that relies on the support of volunteers to function. Our vision is for the club to be supported by sustainable efforts by many as opposed to extraordinary efforts by a few.

- Effective July 1st, 2023 all DCC members 21 and over will be required, as a part of their registered membership, to participate in a minimum of 10 hours of volunteer work per curling season (July 1 to June 30) or pay \$150.
 - First time DCC members and members joining halfway through the season are considered exempt
- Upon registration, members will select a membership option to include volunteering or an additional \$150 fee.
- Members will report their volunteer hours to the club by recording them in a log book or via online form submission.
- In the event a member selected to pay \$150 ultimately completes 10 hours of volunteer work, a \$150 credit will be applied to the member's Leagueapps account.
 - This credit will remain valid until 12 months after the end of the current season. (Ex. Credit earned at any point during the 2023-2024 season would be valid until the end of the 2024-2025 season)
 - A check can be issued instead of Leagueapps credit upon request
- Volunteer hours above and beyond 10 hours per individual member may be applied to other members of the same household.
- Members who do not meet the 10 hours requirement in full will be required to retroactively pay the \$150 fee.
- Volunteer activities include, but are not limited to:
 - Bartending during leagues or events
 - League host
 - Chairing a bonspiel or event
 - Helping to plan or host a bonspiel or event
 - Chairing/participating in a club committee
 - Serving on the Board of Directors
 - Helping at Learn-to-Curl or private events
 - League administration
 - Club maintenance and cleaning
